To help the readers in selecting those journals that are most likely to publish their manuscripts the Index classifies the journals into twenty-eight different topic areas. In addition, the index provides information on the journal's type of review process, number of external reviewers, and acceptance rate. In addition, the Directory includes extensive information on the style and format of most of the journals. The directory provides an ability to compare the characteristic of the manuscript and the needs of each journal.

We are also pleased to report that the Journal of SMET Education: Innovations and Research is now listed in this directory. In the next few issues, we plan to review a few of the journals that are listed in this Directory that are related to SMET education. Thereby, we expect to provide you, our readers, an excellent collection of journals where your articles on innovative educational practices could be published.
